Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report (2021-2022)

Dt: 08-06-2022

Feedback on curriculum from students, faculty, alumni and employers was collected by conducting online surveys and the reports are generated. Based on the reports the analysis made and the actions taken are given below.

I. Analysis

1. Feedback from Students

A large majority of students from both the programs have expressed positive feedback about the curriculum, particularly in areas such as developing critical thinking, communication skills, leadership, and teamwork. However, students have also highlighted a need for more practical exposure and industry-focused training to complement their academic learning. Some students have raised concerns about the lack of advanced courses that reflect current industry practices, particularly in emerging technologies and specialised business areas.

2. Feedback from Faculty

The feedback from faculty is largely positive, appreciating the curriculum's alignment with industry standards, its balance between theory and practice, and the integration of emerging trends and technologies. Faculty members have emphasised the importance of enhancing the practical skills of students and have suggested that more hands-on projects and real-life case studies be incorporated into the curriculum. Some faculty members have also proposed a greater focus on preparing students for high-level research and career development through advanced coursework.

3. Feedback from Alumni

Alumni feedback was generally positive, especially regarding the curriculum's practical applications and alignment with their current roles. Majority of the alumni rated their internship experiences as relevant and beneficial. However, alumni expressed the need for more advanced content and greater integration of digital tools and technologies to help students adapt to the fast-evolving work environment. They also suggested including more global perspectives and international case studies to broaden students' understanding of global business practices.

4. Feedback from Employers

Employers have rated the graduates' technical skills, problem-solving abilities, and teamwork skills as strong. However, they identified areas for improvement in the curriculum, such as the need for more specialised training in industry-specific tools, practical applications, and soft skills such as negotiation, time management, and leadership. Employers have also emphasised the importance of incorporating contemporary issues like sustainability, digital transformation, and ethical business practices into the curriculum to make graduates more competitive in the job market.

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II. Action Taken Report

In response to the feedback from students, faculty, alumni, and employers, the following actions have been implemented or are being planned to enhance the quality of the MBA and MCA programs:

- Enhancement of Practical Learning: To better align with the practical needs of students, the
 college will introduce more industry-focused projects, case studies, and hands-on workshops.
 These will be designed to help students gain real-world experience and apply theoretical
 knowledge to practical situations. Additionally, collaboration with industry partners will be
 increased to provide students with opportunities for live projects, internships, and industrysponsored research.
- 2. Introduction of Advanced Courses: In response to student feedback about the need for more advanced courses, the college will work on introducing specialised courses that align with current industry demands with the help from affiliating university. This will include courses in emerging fields such as artificial intelligence, data analytics, blockchain technology, and digital marketing. These advanced modules will better prepare students for evolving job markets and emerging industries.
- 3. Focus on Soft Skills Development: Employers highlighted the importance of soft skills in graduate employability. To address this, the college will introduce dedicated modules and workshops focusing on communication, negotiation, time management, and leadership. The curriculum will be updated to ensure that students receive a holistic education that includes both technical and interpersonal skill development.
- 4. Global Perspective Integration: In line with alumni feedback, the college will incorporate more global case studies and perspectives into the curriculum. This will help students understand international business dynamics and better prepare them for global career opportunities. Faculty will be encouraged to integrate international examples and encourage cross-cultural discussions within the classroom.
- 5. Upgraded Internship and Career Preparation Programs: The internship program will be further expanded to include more industry-specific exposure, offering students internships in specialised areas such as digital transformation, sustainability, and emerging technologies. The career services team will also offer more personalised career counselling and job-readiness programs, focusing on resume-building, interview preparation, and industry networking.
- 6. Integration of Industry-Specific Tools and Technologies: Based on employer feedback, the curriculum will be updated to include training on industry-specific tools and technologies that graduates are expected to use. This could include tools like SAP for business management, Python for data analysis, or specific software for project management. The college will collaborate with industry experts to offer workshops and certifications in these tools.
