Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report (2022-2023)

Dt: 29-04-2023

Feedback on curriculum from students, faculty, alumni and employers was collected by conducting surveys and the reports are generated. Based on the reports the analysis made and the actions taken are given below.

I. Analysis

1. Feedback from Students

A significant majority of students (around 80% to 85%) across both the MBA and MCA programs provided positive feedback on the curriculum, particularly in areas such as gaining in-depth knowledge, improving critical thinking, enhancing communication skills, promoting leadership abilities, and fostering teamwork. The curriculum was found to support students in achieving the program outcomes and specific objectives to a large extent. However, approximately 15% to 20% of students expressed that the curriculum could be further improved by including advanced courses that better align with current industry trends.

2. Feedback from Faculty

More than 85% of the faculty gave favourable feedback on various aspects of the curriculum, such as its relevance to industry standards, coverage of essential topics, balance between theory and practice, and integration of emerging technologies. Faculty also appreciated the emphasis on developing key skills, including critical thinking, communication, teamwork, and leadership. However, some faculty members noted that there is room for improvement in preparing students for advanced studies and careers, particularly in terms of balancing theoretical knowledge with practical skills.

3. Feedback from Alumni

Alumni expressed positive feedback on the curriculum's relevance to their current jobs, particularly regarding the coverage of fundamental concepts, the inclusion of modern topics, and the balance between theory and practical application. Over 80% of alumni rated the quality of internships and practical experiences as good to excellent, noting the alignment with academic learning. Some alumni, however, indicated a need for better adaptation to new job challenges and the incorporation of more advanced technologies into the curriculum.

4. Feedback from Employers

Employers generally rated the graduates' technical skills, problem-solving abilities, communication skills, teamwork, leadership potential, and adaptability as good to excellent. While the overall feedback on the curriculum was positive, some employers suggested that the curriculum should be updated to include courses that focus on the latest industry trends and practical exercises relevant to the industry. Additional training in specialised skills was also recommended to better prepare students for the evolving job market.
