




Description	<p>On 05.12.2021, Aurora’s PG College (MBA), Uppal partnered with EarthBox Organization to launch the Save Our Lake Initiative, aimed at cleaning and restoring Nallacheruvu lake. This collaborative effort sought to address pollution and enhance the lake’s ecological health.</p> <p>Activities included removing litter, debris, and invasive plant species from the lake and surrounding areas. Volunteers conducted a thorough sweep of the lake’s shorelines and water, collecting plastic, metal, and other waste materials. 
